

BOATING SAFETY CLASSES

March 29 & April 5, 2008 – Sponsored by Worcester County Sail and Power Squadron. This will be held at the **Stoddard Army Reserve Center**, 25 N. Lake Ave, Worcester, MA. Upon successful completion of the exam, each participant will receive a Safe Boating Certificate with the Personal Watercraft Endorsement meeting the Mass. State requirements. Cost, for course & materials is \$75.00pp. For the 2nd family member, exam only, no materials, the cost is \$35.00.
