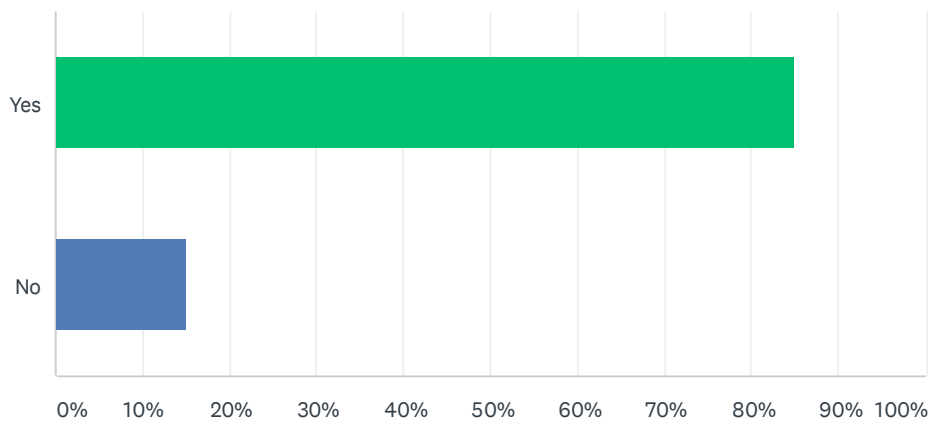

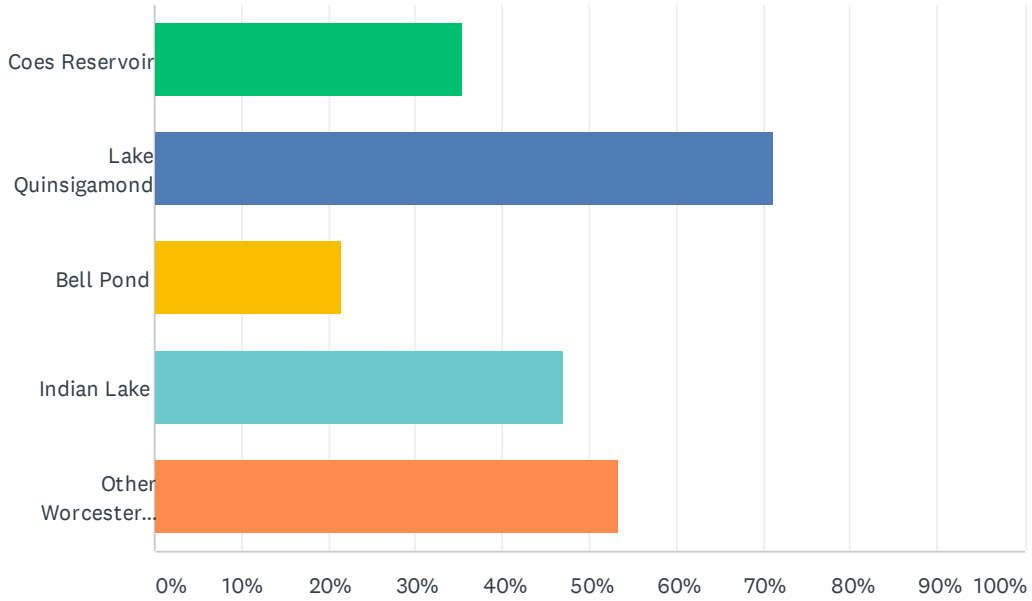

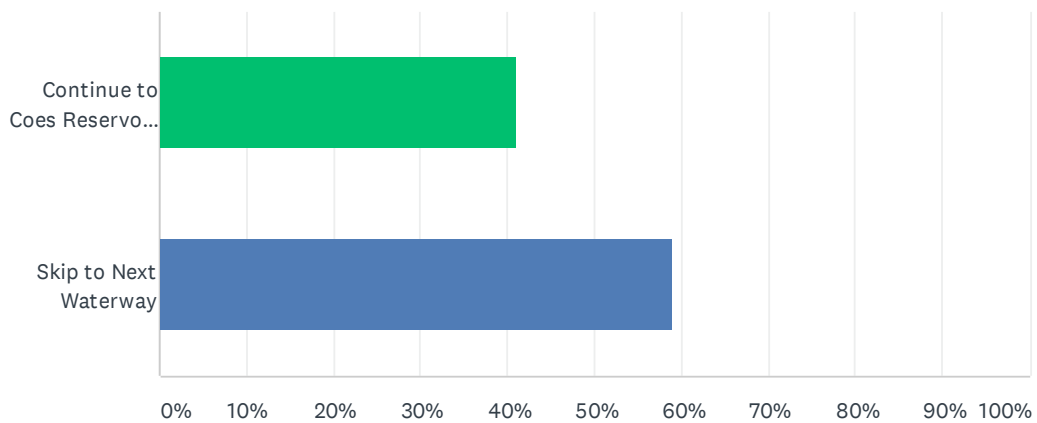

Bass and pickerel especially are much smaller on average and less active, which as the apex predators (given the very minute presence of pike and the loss of tiger Muskie from the lake) is not a good sign for the overall health of the lake. Perch population is massive. There feels like there are more perch in this lake than any other fish and dropping a neutral non-targeted bait (such as a worm) is more likely to net a perch than any other fish. 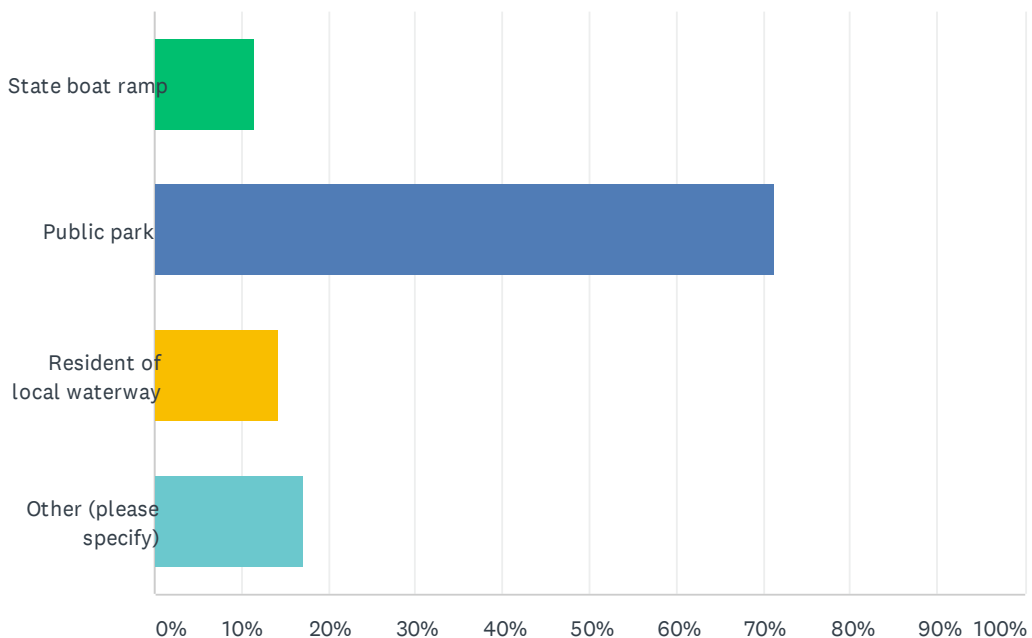
